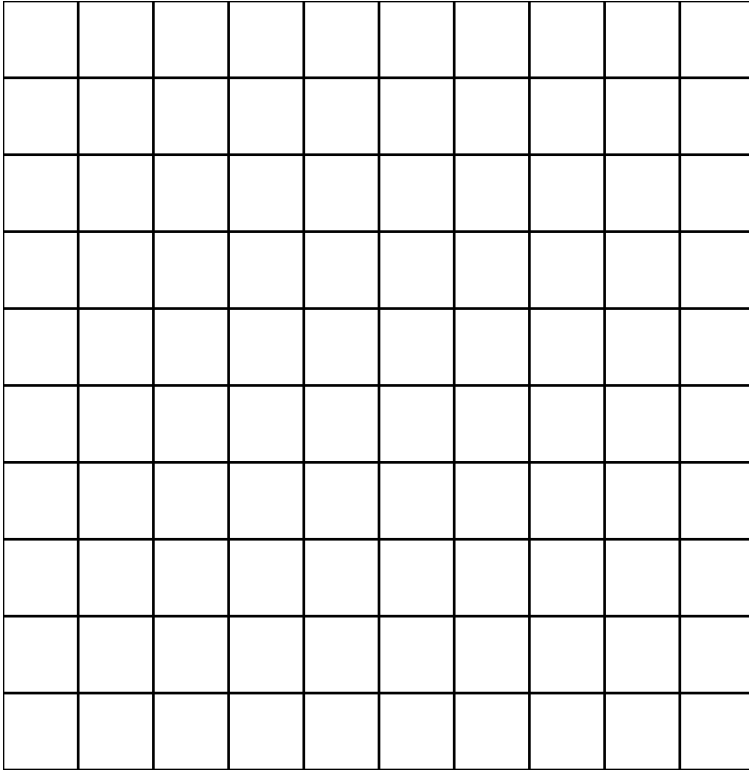


# Percents Review

# What is a percent?

Percent means “Out of 100” or “Per 100”



Converting a percent to a fraction

1) 18%

2) 40%

3) 75%

4) 50%

# Converting Fractions to Percents

1)  $\frac{9}{10}$

2)  $\frac{4}{5}$

3)  $\frac{17}{25}$

# **Helpful Page to Memorize**

Below are some common percents that you should remember.

<b><i>Common Percents</i></b>					
$10\% = \frac{1}{10}$	$20\% = \frac{1}{5}$	$25\% = \frac{1}{4}$	$30\% = \frac{3}{10}$	$40\% = \frac{2}{5}$	$50\% = \frac{1}{2}$
$60\% = \frac{3}{5}$	$70\% = \frac{7}{10}$	$75\% = \frac{3}{4}$	$80\% = \frac{4}{5}$	$90\% = \frac{9}{10}$	$100\% = 1$
